

Plains Inn & Antiques

Plains, Georgia



This adaptive reuse of two historically significant buildings in downtown Plains, Georgia, created a 7-suite Inn and Antique shop. Totalling 11,500 SF, the buildings feature retail space for antique sales on the street level along with a small historic display about former President Jimmy Carter, Plains most famous son.

The second floor features seven over-night suites. Interior design has been coordinated by Mrs. Rosalynn Carter. The decorations and furnishings of each suite represent a decade of President Carter's life from the 1920s through the 1980s. The Presidential Suite represents the 1970s, when Mr. Carter served as President of the United States.

Led by the Plains Better Hometown Program, this project is part of a redevelopment effort for Plains. The project will be linked to other area attractions via a site-seeing train.
