The Summit Club's fine dining experience is anchored by the best view of the city from its 25th floor vantage point atop the City Center in South Bend.

Working on a 30-day, fast-track program, the Interior Design Team at The Troyer Group set out to give the Summit Club a complete interior update. The design Team created a contemporary theme, but wanted finishes and colors that were timeless, not trendy. They strived for an interior that would be the perfect complement to the Club.

Working with Forsey Construction, the Team completely gutted the Club in three days. This included the lobby, the long hallway from the elevator, service stations, ceilings, doors, the lounge, lighting and men's and women's restrooms.

Originally, when members would exit the elevator on the 25th floor, the ambience from the elevator to the restaurant was not exciting. The design Team set out to create an experience for the members and their guests from the moment they exited the elevator. They removed the bulkheads, fake columns and the dark wood. The existing dark wooden doors were replaced with glass doors, completely lighting up the entry.

Members wishing to unwind in the lounge now enjoy the new, uplifting bubble theme, complete with floating clouds and carpeting donned in bubbles.
